governments and other organizations in which there are an insufficient number of contact hours being offered on a campus to provide faculty on that campus with a full-time teacher position. This determination shall be made by the State Board.

Army and non-teaching days may be considered as time spent for computing the equivalent of a year's time of service duty.

2. Initial Enrollment

(A) **Non-Resident Student with Dependents:** When a non-resident student with dependents enrolls in teacher studies for the day she is qualified. The teacher studies must be completed before the dependent child reaches the age of 18 years.

(B) **Non-Resident Student without Dependents:** When a non-resident student without dependents enrolls in teacher studies for the day she is qualified.

(C) **Resident Army Recruit:** The Non-Resident student will be granted credit for the number of months spent in basic training, provided she has completed at least one month of basic training.

(D) **Non-Resident Student with Dependents:** When a non-resident student with dependents enrolls in teacher studies for the day she is qualified, by mutual agreement, for the number of months spent in basic training, provided she has completed at least one month of basic training for the above student.

(E) **Non-Resident Student with Non-Teaching Dependents:** When a non-resident student with non-teaching dependents enrolls in teacher studies for the day she is qualified, the number of months spent in basic training, provided she has completed at least one month of basic training, shall be assigned to another dependents (as to a second section or another person), until those who have completed have been assigned. After completing the second section or having released him or her from basic training, the student may be assigned to another dependents.

As a result, the new system will be able to identify and track individual patients across different healthcare settings.

During 2001, Primary and Secondary school enrollment increased by 10% and 12% respectively. Total enrollment increased by 11%. This growth was due to increased enrollment in primary schools, while secondary schools saw a slight decrease.
