- You may withdrawyour complaint or involvement from the Collegeprocess at any time.
- Every college shall ensure that, at a minimum, at the first instance of disclosure by a reporting individual to a college representative, the following information shall be presented to to report individual. You have the right to make a report to Campus Security, local law enforcement, and/or State Police or choose not to report; to report the incident to your institution; to be protected by the institution from retaliation for reporting an incident; and to receive assistance and resources from your institution."

You are encouraged to let hospital personnel know if you do not want your insurance policyholder to be notified about your access to these services.
